All food and food scraps, including meat, dairy, bones, seafood and oil; non-recyclable paper

- Boxes from refrigerated & frozen food; pizza boxes
- Coffee filters & grounds, tea bags
- Cotton items
- Dairy - cheese; drain milk and yogurt in sink
- Dryer lint/dust bunnies
- Egg cartons/egg shells
- Milk & juice cartons (waxed cardboard, not foil lined)
- Paper plates & cups; paper take out containers (remove metal); paper towels & napkins; tissues, tissue paper; gift wrap
- Pumpkins
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Waxed paper

NO ✗

No metal, glass, plastic, ceramic or rubber. No yard waste...yet.

- Candles, crayons, wax
- Cigarette butts/cigars
- Cleaning products, chemicals, detergents, soaps,
- Foil, foil bags, candy wrappers
- Juice boxes & other foil-lined containers
- Kitty litter/pet waste
- Personal hygiene products - Band-aids, bandages, diapers, gauze, tampons, pads, make-up, shampoo, baby wipes
- Plastic of any kind including plastic wrap, bags, packaging, plastic plates, knives and forks, baggies
- Recyclables: clean paper, plastic bottles, metal, or glass (recycle in usual manner)
